CHESSBOXING as a Sport

The hybrid sport was envisioned in 1992 by cartoonist Enki Bilal and chess boxing was featured in his graphic novel FROID EQUATEUR. Iepe Rubing brought the concept to life. Fighting under the name lepe the Joker.

In 1997 a movie by director Joseph Kuo called "Ninja checkmate", the English dubbed USA version was known as the "Mystery of Chess Boxing," It does not feature chessboxing, but it is probably the inspiration for the Wu-Tang-Clan song "Da mystery of Chessboxing" on their first album Enter the Wu-Tang (36 chamber) (1993).

Hence Chessboxing requires both mental & physical strength. It is the smartest & toughest contest on the planet. Chessboxers either have to checkmate or knockout in the boxing ring.

Chessboxing will be promoted at the university level by proper presentation of Chess in the ring with a calm and composed mind and a Physical Boxing round with the same opponent through alternate rounds of Chess and Boxing. The sport preserves both the nature calm and thrilling. Player might win by checkmate in chess round or knockout in boxing round.
